- MEMBERS CURRENTLY STORING A PRIVATE BOAT AT LEANDER:

- If your rack is not paid for by March 31st 2025 and not removed from that rack by docks-in day, it will be removed for you and placed in the compound to make space for other boats.
- You must pay your membership and storage fees by March 31st to keep your current rack classification or you may lose it to someone on the waiting list.
- If you would like to store your shell in a new location (i.e. move it from outside to inside), you must first pay your membership and boat storage for your current location. Next, email leander.clerk@gmail.com asking to have your name placed on the waitlist for your desired location (you will be put on the waitlist once payment has been received).
- Please refer to the *NEW* LBC Private Boat Storage Policy for full details.
- Rented lockers will be labeled with the member's name and are permitted to have locks on them 24/7.
- CURRENT LOCKER USERS: payment must be received by March 31st. On April 1st, all unclaimed lockers and locker room items will be emptied into the lost and found.
